## **Steps Required for PYC Nomination**

3. Have the nominee(s) and a parent/guardian complete and sign the Signature Page, after they have carefully read the "About PYC" section below, paying special attention to the retreat attendance commitment.
3. Have the church Session endorse the nomination and have the appropriate church official sign the Session Endorsement form.
4. Gather the Signature Page and Session Endorsement and submit them together by <b>Friday May 31, 2024</b> . (Emailing a scanned copy is fine.) Also confirm that your youth has completed the online portion by that date.

### **ABOUT PYC**

- Youth members shall be active members of a Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) in the Presbytery of St. Andrew and presently (when nominated) in grades 9, 10, or 11. Normally, selected youth will serve on the PYC until they graduate from high school.
- PYC members have the responsibilities of planning, promoting, and sharing leadership of youth events for the presbytery.
- PYC members are expected to:
  - Set a Christian example for other youth.
  - Work cooperatively with others.

- Attend the 2 stated PYC planning retreats each year. (Note: In an effort to enable full participation from all PYC members, this is one less planning retreat than previous years. See more information about planning retreats below.)
- Attend Zooms as needed between in-person retreats (frequency/schedule TBD based on need and PYC availability).
- Attend and help lead the winter/spring retreat for youth of the presbytery.
- PYC members will receive:
  - reimbursement for expenses incurred in carrying out their duties.
  - leadership training and experience.
  - the joy of serving God through this youth ministry.
- The work of 2024-2025 PYC members will begin with a planning retreat August 2-4, 2024. Dates for one additional planning retreat, as well as the main retreat, will be set at that time. All of the retreats take place at Camp Hopewell. It is vitally important that all members of PYC be able to attend the initial planning retreat since the dates for subsequent meetings are set, theme and plans for the winter retreat are established, and the group develops as a leadership team.

#### ABOUT THE SELECTION PROCESS

- New PYC members should be nominated by representatives of the church's youth, youth advisors, staff, and the Session. For churches without designated youth leaders, a teacher or adult familiar with the youth may make the nomination. All nominees shall be endorsed by the Session of their church.
- All nominees will be considered by the PYC Advisors, and selections will receive final approval from the presbytery's Education, Nurture and Worship Committee.
- Final approval will take place by June 8 and youth and churches will be notified after selection.

Nominations must be received by FRIDAY, MAY 31, 2024.
